My Home Group

When I was about five years sober I joined a small group that meets in the rear of a church building on Sundays, as a home group member not really knowing what it means to be a home group member. I consider this group to be my first home group. The only reason I joined this group was because my sponsor at the time wanted me to do so. A year later, she was diagnosed with lung cancer. When chemotherapy made her unable to drive, I would take her to this meeting every Sunday. She attended this meeting until she lost all her mobility due to the spread of the cancer to her brain.

This home group and its members taught me about responsibility, service work and helping others. I served as an intergroup rep, GSR, cake maker (more like a cake bringer, honesty here) and fill in for anything the group needed.

More importantly, they taught me compassion, which I think is the highest form of spirituality. I remember showing up at the meeting right after my sponsor's funeral. The support and love they gave me was indescribable. One of the ladies there handed me an old tattered 12&12 that was left in the group's trunk. She said, "I think you should have this". It had been my sponsor's 12&12. It had drawings and notes by my sponsor. I still have that book. I still go to this meeting. To this day I don't think the lady knows how much that meant to me and I still see her at this meeting today. I don't believe we can go to many places today where we still see the same people occupying the same chairs to just share their love and compassion.



Once a girl who I haven't seen in the meetings for a long time came to this meeting. I went to give her a hug and she said, "I knew you would be here". This was a direct result from what I was taught. And that is, to be always at my home group no matter what. I feel inadequate to report that I am at times unable to full fill this responsibility.

I have a new home group today. I serve as a key holder and an intergroup rep. It is a privilege to know that I can be a trusted servant under a loving God. When I first got sober, my own sister wished me dead and did not trust me with ten dollars. I was a person who could not be trusted then. Through AA and its principles, I was reborn. To show my gratitude, I want to be the one who transmits the love and compassion I learned from my first home group, to those who come through the door of my home group today. The AA Grapevine defines home group as a 'heartbeat of AA' and I am responsible for the beat to go on. When the beat stops, heart dies and we all perish.

So I ask God to let me remain sober so I can be here for ANYONE who reaches out for help.

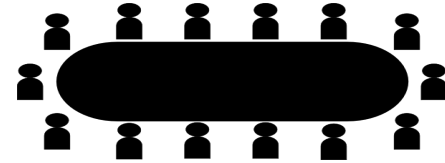

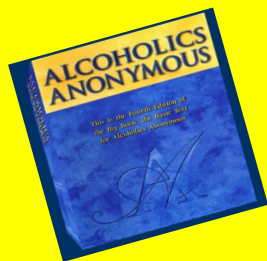

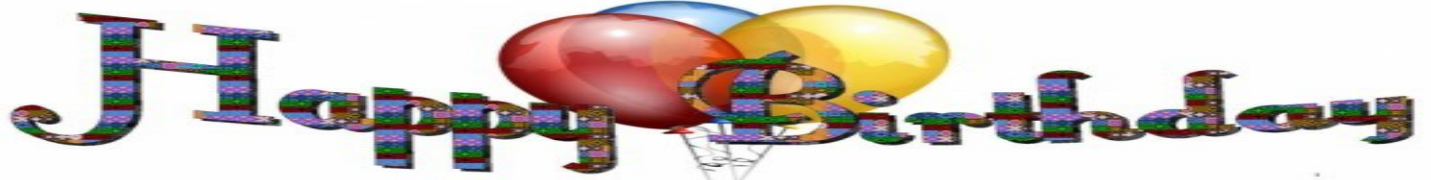

Heard it through the Grapevine

February, 2016

Meeting with my sponsor is always enlightening. We sit down in a pleasant place, agree to allow 10 minutes apiece grousing about small petty personal problems, and then devote the remainder of our time together toward discussing some real issues. Sometimes just talking through a concern with a trusted AA friend yields an immediate answer; frequently I find that I know what to do but I just needed concurrence from my sponsor. Other times we agree to disagree, which means I stubbornly refuse the sound advice given and after pursuing MY way, I wish I had listened to my friend instead. And other times, we just don't have answers and agree to "Do The Next Right Thing". But this opens up a whole litany of questions such as "what exactly is the next right thing?, will I know the right thing if it appears right in front of me? or my favorite, how long do I have to wait for the right thing to appear? As you can see, I'm a bit impatient. But here is good advice from AA while I'm waiting for the answer. "Just do the next thing right". I feel this is a pretty good answer for me. Most of the time, I know what the "right" thing to do is, especially when I use what I've heard and learned in AA. Not only that, but the longer I am sober I find I am developing a more dependable moral, ethical, compassionate, and spiritual "compass" to guide me. And finally, it moves my focus to the circumstances directly in front of me, keeps my thinking simple, and prevents me from obsessing about when, where or how "The Next Right Thing" will be revealed to me. Wishing you the best your sobriety brings you each day!
