5. Skip any drinking occasion you are nervous about. Remember how clever you were at excuses when drinking? Now put the talent to good use. No office party is as important as saving your life.



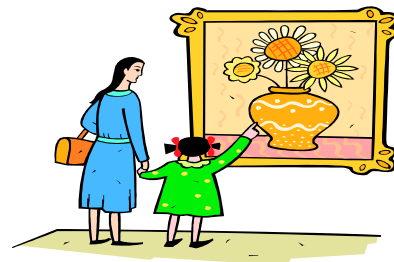
6. If you have to go to a drinking party and can't take an A.A. with you, keep some candy handy.

Northeast Florida Intergroup Prudent Reserve Calculation

This calculation is used to determine the maximum amount that would be in the prudent reserve based on 8 months of operating expenses.

The amount of operating expenses is determined yearly from the expenses reported on intergroup's Form 990, tax return. The prudent reserve calculation uses the operating expenses from the past 3 years and their average would determine the "operating expenses" for the calculation. The amount is divided by 12 to determine the amount of monthly operating expenses which is then multiplied by 8 to determine the maximum prudent reserve for the year. The calculation for 2015 is illustrated below:

Operating Expenses:	2015	\$ 77,052
	2014	77,619
	2013	62,637
	Total	\$217,308 / 3 = \$ 72,436 average for past 3 years

Monthly operating expenses using 3 year average: \$ 72,436 / 12 = \$ 6,036 per month Prudent reserve calculation: \$ 6,036 X 8 = \$ 48,288

Based on the prudent reserve balance at October 31, 2016 of \$ 42,343 it represents 42,343/6036 = 7.02 months of operating expenses.

When the calculation is made using only the prior year's operating expenses it represents 42,343/6421 = 6.60 months of operating expenses.

Two by laws changes have been proposed by the Intergroup Body.

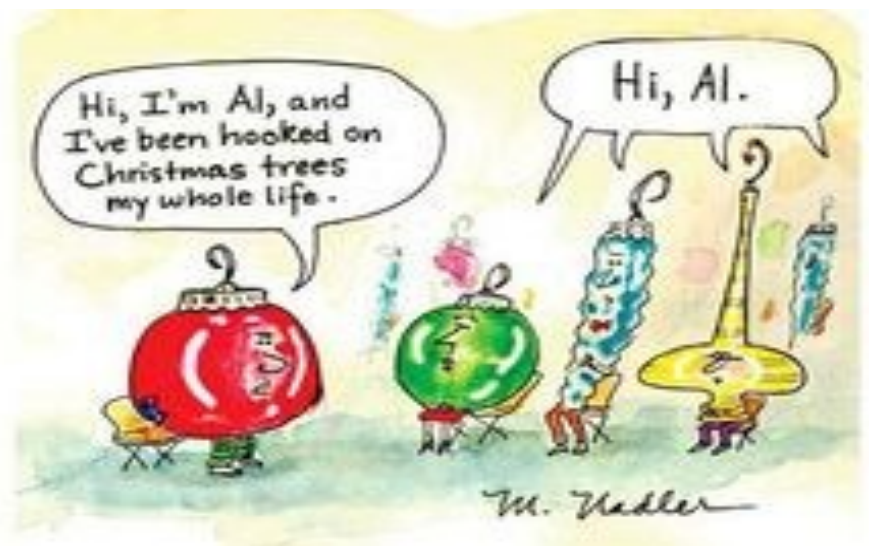

By Law Change to separate Intergroup Vice Chair and the Treasurer position into two (2) separate offices.

MOTION: To create Vice Chairman position to be elected by the Intergroup body. This position will run concurrently with the Chair

By Law Change have a Prudent Reserve Limit:

MOTION: The Intergroup will have no more than eight (8) months of operating expenses in the prudent reserve.

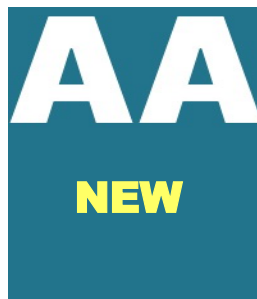

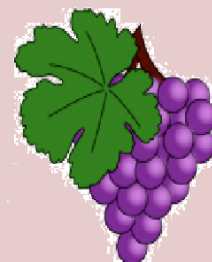

Heard it through the Grapevine
December, 2016

I read a story in the November, 2016 Grapevine about going out and then coming back into the fellowship; not only once, but many times. I have never “relapsed” but I’m certainly not some kind of alcoholic wonder-kin. I am an alcoholic just like you who has managed to stay sober despite myself and my insane mind, one day at a time, day after day after day. Early on I had great sponsors, went to many meetings, and tried to work the steps and improve myself. But the one thing I have held onto through the years is that somehow I was miraculously granted the sober gift of a second chance at life and if I blew off this chance, it would never come back for me again. There is also one other picture in my mind that I keep close, and it’s just like I hear in meetings. I picture my last horrible drunk and seeing myself in the mirror the next day; a miserable excuse for a dying woman. And this is the point in the Grapevine story “*Counting Days With Eddy*”. The author witnesses a fellow newcomer who stacks up the days and then disappears, comes back in and leaves again, and returns for awhile and goes back out so that finally “she won’t be coming back in.” She has died of acute alcohol poisoning. The author writes this. “*My first sponsor, quoting from the Big Book, said to me one time, “Remember that we deal with Alcohol-cunning, baffling, powerful! What is the most important word in that sentence?” “Baffling?” I replied. “Nope,” he said. “Powerful?” “Try again.” “Cunning?” “Strike three. The most important word in that sentence is “Remember.”*”
