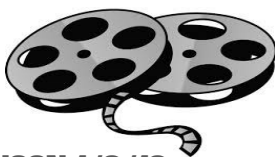

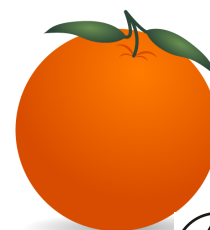

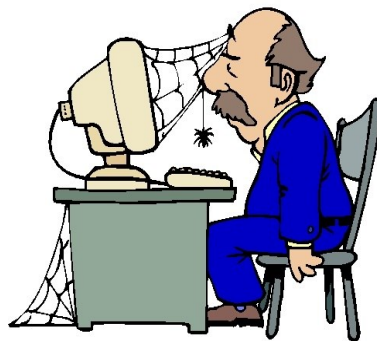

P.A. Volunteer ALBERT I. — Rest In Peace



On December 2nd, our beloved Phone Army Volunteer, ALBERT, died. He was a dedicated, loyal Phone Army Volunteer, and told me several times that he really enjoyed working on the Phone Army. (Whenever the Intergroup Office is closed for holidays, the Phone Army Volunteers fill in so that our phones are always answered by someone in AA, a REAL PERSON, not an answer machine.)

Although Albert has been a volunteer on the Phone Army since September 2016, I never got to meet him face-to-face. I knew Albert through his voice, though, and that's the way most people who call the "The Hotline" or "Phone Army" number know all of the Volunteers.

Whether it is a traveling business person just visiting the area for a day, a family on vacation looking for a meeting close by, or a heart-wrenching 12 Step Call, we are known by our voices – dedicated Volunteers who answer the Intergroup phone number, 904-399-8535, at any hour of any day, holidays included! And we're always "there" to help.

Albert will be sorely missed! I thank him for his dedication to the Phone Army, his love for AA, his deep desire to help another alcoholic even though his body was giving out on him, and for his example of living out our AA credo – "I am responsible." *-Holly C., Phone Army Chair*
