# DROP THE ROCK GROUP



*Drop the Rock: Removing Character Defects & The Ripple Effect*

By working the 6th and 7th Steps, we are less likely in recovery to stay stuck in old, unproductive, negative behavior patterns. We gain more understanding on how all the Steps, although ordered for a reason, need to be worked together. This prevents us from falling into the trap of understanding just enough of the program to make us miserable and not enough to make us happy. The action of the 6th and 7th Steps culminates in "Dropping the Rock" - all the stubborn, grasping, unreasonable holding on to old patterns of behavior, thinking and feeling that are harmful to our progress in recovery.

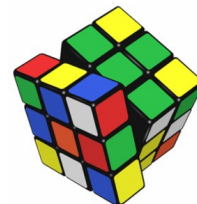
