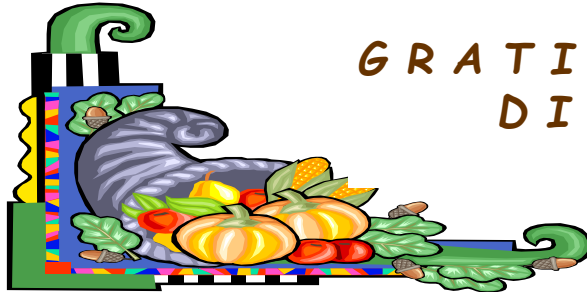

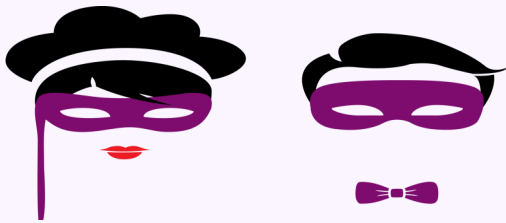


# ANONYMOUS, BUT NOT INVISIBLE MASQUERADE BALL 2018

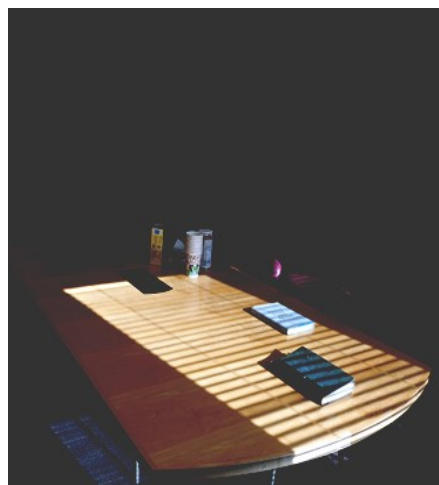
