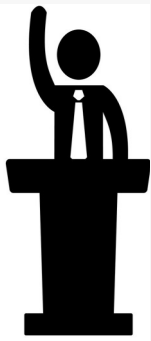


What will I be doing?

The Fifth Tradition and Primary Purpose Groups

“Each group has but one primary purpose – to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers.” From the Big Book of A.A.


“It is the great paradox of A.A. that we know we can seldom keep the precious gift of sobriety unless we give it away.” From the Twelve and Twelve book of A.A.

“A vast communications net now covers the earth, even to its remotest reaches... nothing matters more to AA’s future welfare than the manner in which we use the colossus of modern communication. Used unselfishly and well, it can produce results surpassing our present imagination.” Bill W., The AA Grapevine, November 1960.

An A.A. group in Austin, Texas, developed a Primary Purpose Group (PPG) meeting format based on A.A. literature. I’ve been to a few PPG meetings in Northeast Florida and they are a bit different from other meetings.

After the formalities common to A.A. meetings, a designated member reads about four paragraphs from a book. Then the chairperson for the meeting asks questions. The answers to the questions are from the reading, line by line. Everyone at the meeting either has a book, or is provided with a book. Thus, everyone, in turn, answers a question.


The PPG format slows things down a bit and that gives participants a few moments to think on what they’ve been reading. The PPG format is being used by AA groups all over the world, including the following groups and meetings in NEFL.Submitted by Danny

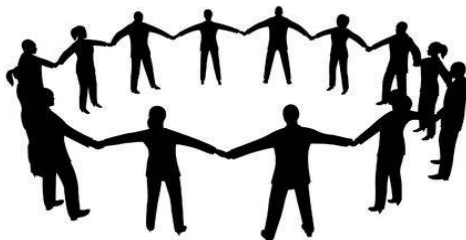
