“Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio and films.

3. Am I careful about throwing AA names around—even within the Fellowship?
4. Am I ashamed of being a recovered, or recovering, alcoholic?
5. What would AA be like if we were not guided by the ideas in Tradition Eleven? Where would I be?
6. Is my AA sobriety attractive enough that a sick drunk would want such a quality for himself?”

My first day of sobriety and the following 29 days were spent going to an outpatient treatment facility. This was my second time around, and one of the few things I was willing to accept about myself this time was that I needed structure, routine, and most importantly, as much as I hated it, someone to tell me what I had to do and when to do it. Although my days were filled, that still left the “witching hour”, better known as Happy Hour”, to get through on my own.



Fortunately for me, there were now meetings at all times of the day and night and I could fill up those “desperate hours” with a meeting and then hanging around as long as possible afterward chatting with fellow A.A. members. It was imperative that I have as little “alone time” as possible since that was how I had filled my life for the better part of 30 years. When they would finally kick us out of the San Marco Club so they could close, I would go home and read the Big Book until I got sleepy.

After a few weeks, it got better. I had an entirely new network of people now and I took advantage of it from the start. We went out to dinner after meetings, we had cookouts and card games at our houses and football parties. I was actually having the time of my life! If I got antsy, frustrated, or scared, I actually had a Sponsor to call to help me through it. She made sure I had plenty of reading and writing to do during my “down



time” and even though it galled me at times to have someone guiding and instructing me, I had to admit it was working. This was not the time for my pride and rebellious nature to take over. After all, that was what I

always did before, and she reminded me that it obviously hadn’t worked. I think that’s what the most important aspect of sponsorship in the first year; someone to be a constant voice telling you that you don’t know anything at all about living life sober.

Everyone has their own way of getting through the first year of sobriety; but I think they have a choice to make it an exciting and happy time as opposed to a difficult and negative time. After all, this is an opportunity to “Start Over”, the second chance at life and we are given the best possible tools to do it with... the 12 Steps of A.A. and the fellowship of people working them.

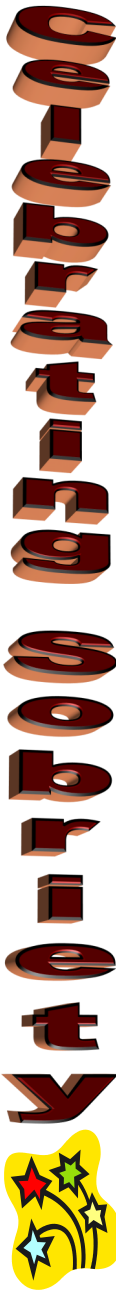
