I relate it to living in a different city. I still remember that I was raised and lived in Georgia. I can still find my way around there but it was a different time and that is not where I live now. It surprises me that alcohol no longer calls me. When God delivered me He released me completely from the terrible obsession to drink. The bad behaviors of dishonesty and adultery left earlier than the drinking obsession so I truly am a new creature today.



Working the steps and following my sponsor's suggestions was not always easy but so worth it. I know that I can always drop back into my old ways if I pick up a drink but I choose to stay in close contact with my sponsor and maintain a strong spiritual life. Of course, this is not a guarantee that I will stay sober but it sure has worked well for a number of years now.

Service work and regular meeting attendance keep me in good standing. I stay in gratitude and know how very blessed I am. When I hear of other long time members who have slipped up and picked up the bottle again it scares me because I know they are no better or different than me. Then I can recommit myself to my Higher Power and pray a little harder to stay sober.

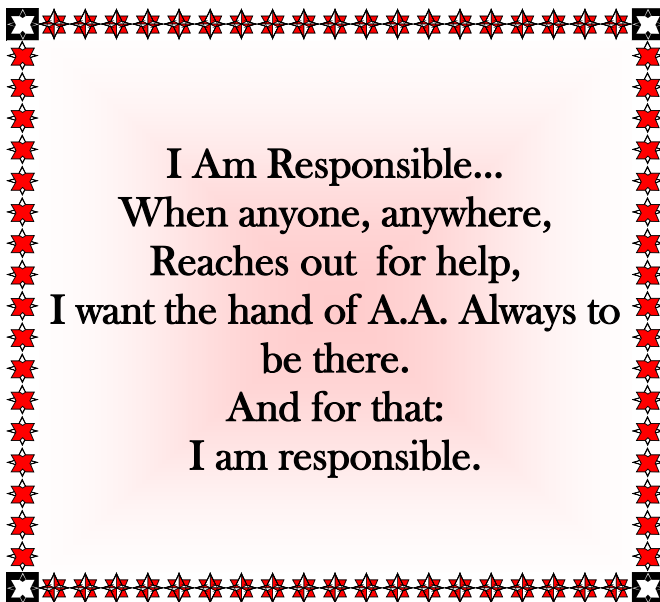
