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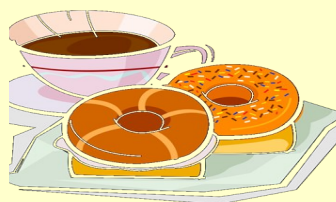

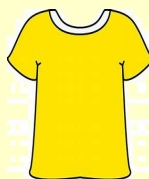

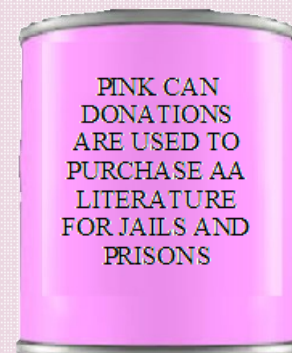

What is a Pink Can?

***THE PINK CAN SUPPORTS
LITERATURE TO
CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS***



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Your home group or Intergroup Rep is requested to bring before the group at a business meeting a consideration and group vote to participate in the Pink Can Drive. If your group conscience votes to participate then a pink can will be provided to your group.

COMMON QUESTIONS: What is the money used for? The money is used to buy AA approved literature (books and pamphlet's) for jails and institutions in your area.

Is this something new? No, the pink can is a method of fund raising for jails and prisons and has a long history in A.A.

Who handles the money and auditing systems are in place? The typical way money is handled is through your group treasurer. When a designated amount is raised, "Say \$100, the groups Intergroup Rep would bring the money raised to the Intergroup Business Meeting or to the local Intergroup Office. These amounts then would be made available to the Corrections Committee.

Will this take away from our group? No. This does not replace the Seventh Tradition. This is just an outreach groups can support. Frequently members donate spare change or make an annual contribution on their birthday. Historically members have made contributions of a dollar for every year of sobriety. These are just ideas. You donate any amount you choose.

Appendix X: FINANCIAL

FINANCING: Funds for operations shall be by individual and group contributions, the sale of literature and other approved items and fund raisers.

The IG Chair, Vice Chair and Treasurer have signatory authority for checks written on the IG account. Two signatures will be required for authentication of any check and no expenditure over \$1,000, whether a one-time expense or cumulative, with the exception of literature purchases, rent, payroll, or banquet expenses will be made without prior approval from a majority present at a regularly scheduled or special meeting of the IG body.

The fiduciary officers shall consist of the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and Treasurer. Two of the three signatures are required on all banking transactions, with one signature preferably being the Treasurer's. These officers are also responsible for signing contracts for Northeast Florida IG Services, Inc. The IG office shall maintain a cashbox fund not to exceed \$100.00 for the POS system

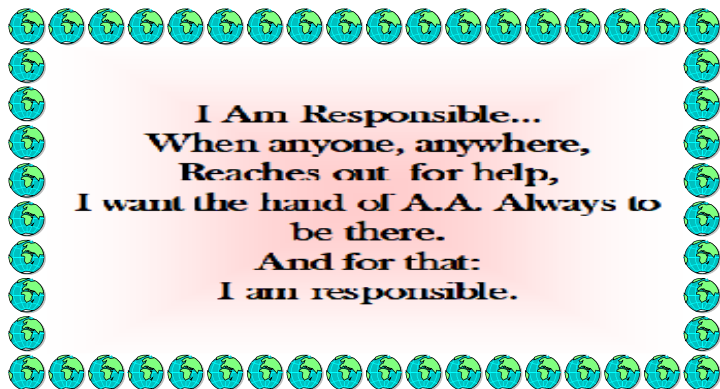
