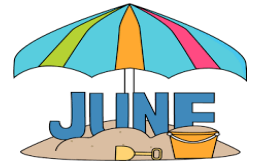

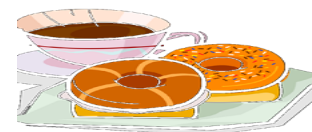

### My First Visit to 855 Ardmore Avenue, Akron, Ohio

In the spring of 1998, my wife and I decided to take a trip to Ohio to visit family. We both automatically thought about a visit to Dr. Bob's house. What a great opportunity doing two things we wanted to do on the same trip. We were eager to go. Helen and I initially met in the program in 1971. Over the years we had seen pictures of 855 Ardmore and always wanted to make a visit. Here was our chance. With great anticipation we set out for Ohio and at last arrived in Akron.

Once we were parked across from the house we just sat there for a minute or two and looked at the house with a sense of amazement. Here is where it all started. Our lives were forever changed by events that happened there. We got out of the car and headed for the steps. Of course, Helen went straight up the stairs. I walked on the street and started to take pictures. When I looked up, she was already off the porch and in the house.

While I was on the street looking up at the house, I thought it was just a nice historic AA site. I had no special feelings. I was just happy to be finally here at Bob's house. I went to the stairs and counted each as I went up to the front door. Twelve, I smiled when I realized the significance of that number. I thought, "This is where it all started, the home of AA. The program had saved both of our lives, Wow." I know I had a great big smile on my face.



I took my time when I got to the porch, I wanted to soak it all in. What a great opportunity. The significance of the house was starting to sink in. I put the camera strap over my shoulder to free my hands and reached for the door handle.

Here I was at the threshold of 855 Ardmore. There was no one in sight so I let myself in. My Life changed in an instant. As I moved forward with my hand on the doorknob with my right foot in the motion of stepping in, I was transformed. An overwhelming feeling, an indescribable sensation enveloped my entire body. It was beyond description, I couldn't think. I remember it started as a strong energy at the top of my head and radiated to my shoulders and chest. It was as though I was having an out of body experience. Frozen in the doorway I didn't want to move, I was transfixed with feelings. It was as though I had been captured in a time warp in the exact spot where the program began, the most spiritual place in the world. At this exact spot my recovery had begun.

I had to take a couple of slow breaths to compose myself. There was a tingling on my face and arms. I was still stunned. I asked myself, "What just happened?" I looked around to get centered, to gain control. To my left was the entrance to the kitchen and to the right the living room. I took a few more slow, deep breaths.

In another minute or two I heard Helen and the volunteer calling from the basement. I quickly went to join them. From there Helen and I spent a lot of time exploring the house, asking questions and purchasing books and medallions. It was great to see the movie upstairs. I kept taking pictures.

After we got home and over the years, I have shared this experience with others, I have had a spiritual experience each time I have shared what happened to me at the threshold of 855 Ardmore. I have been so choked up with emotion that I have cried at the podium as I shared. This is just how powerful the experience was and still is for me.
