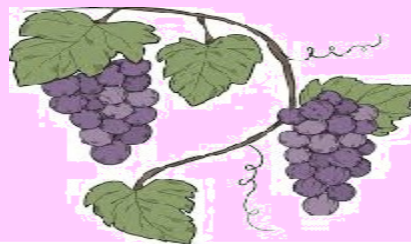

In Memory

Hi(her) story of some of the early ladies in AA from the Westside of Jacksonville

I got sober in 1979 at St Mark's Episcopal church. I was a newlywed. Soon we were transferred to Virginia for 2 years and there I found meetings and my first sponsor. When we returned to Jacksonville 3 years later I found the Timuquana Ladies meeting at St Peters Episcopal Church in the church's nursery room. It was a handful of women there who helped me. Their names are now fuzzy. I remember Louise S. and Maggie S., who told me when I complained, "we don't care how they did it in Virginia, you'll have to learn Jacksonville's way"! I also went to the old Westside Group when it met on Cassatt Avenue and had a chat with Maggie W. who sold me my Came To Believe book because "you look like you can afford it". Later she donated the land that the Westside Club stands on. She was known for disliking profanity.

According to the "Jacksonville AA Tree" the meeting of Timuquana Ladies was founded in 1973. I needed daytime meetings because my husband was deploying again and I had 2 sons who I could take to a Mother's Morning Out. I attended Timuquana Ladies and met Phyllis D. on Thursdays and the Lunch Bunch Meeting at CSX Wednesdays where I met Mary S. Both of those women became sponsors to me at different times. I also learned recently that Mary S. started the Fruit Cove and Switzerland Meetings. I was able to add the Saturday Ladies Meeting at Westside where I met Monteen H., the schoolteacher who hid her vodka in her desk drawer and helped me through those lean meeting years by letting me try the "can I stay sober with my church which always had childcare for its events?" She said "Do the experiment and check back with me" I found I had to put AA meetings first! I also remember Phyllis D., "you've come a long way, baby", Flo C. and Peg D. "put down the shit stick". Sheila H. also came to the Saturday Westside ladies meeting. All of these women sponsored many women over the years. Sheila was another founder of the Westside Club. All died with over 25 years of sobriety.

By this time my sons were in grade school and I had more meetings I could attend. I noticed that St Peters Church had childcare during the Thursday 11:00 meeting, so we approached the Rector of St Peter's Church about making use of their nursery for new moms wanting to get sober. That started 20 years of babysitting that helped moms quit drinking much sooner in their disease. We also became self-supporting by passing a second basket to pay the babysitters.

Phyllis D. spent many hours volunteering at the old Intergroup Office in San Marco helping the Secretary Elaine F. with the Intergroup work. Phyllis, my 3rd sponsor was a master of the "voluntold" method of assigning service positions in Timuquana Ladies, and I became an Intergroup Representative when it met at Riverside Presbyterian Church on Sundays. Timuquana Ladies shared service commitments with the Thursday evening St Peters Church meeting. We alternated taking evening meetings to Fourth Street, an early halfway house. At the evening Timuquana meeting, I met Millie M. and her husband, and later her granddaughter. Millie was famous for saying in her Boston Brogue "You got's to stay **SOBAH!**" to the van load of Navy men in trouble with their drinking.

Recently I have "met" Bernice M. She was a member of Winners Club and active in Corrections. She loved the yearly motorcycle rides that the sober AAs had. Our meeting was not face-to-face, but through memories by her niece who shares grandchildren with me.

The Westside Saturday Ladies Meeting was home to Linda L. who I first met at the old Tom S.'s meeting on Downing Street behind his house. I was invited by Carole M. to go to that meeting with the old guard of westside AA. She was the only woman who I was able to call in the wee hours because I was near to drinking. And finally, June Q. who spent her early sobriety in St Croix but moved here 20 years ago. She also was dedicated to the Intergroup office and Timuquana Ladies. We were opposites in a few ways especially in the thickness of our skin. She used to say "if you have something to tell me do it, don't hint around".

I wanted the Westside AA HER-stories to be written before I forget who shepherded me through the years.
