This is because of our unrelenting selfishness. These decisions then "rippled" out into our relationships, our job, and the world itself. When the consequences of those decisions started appearing, we chose to blame others, to resent others and to play the victim. But were not our troubles basically of our own making? In this workshop our Group will help you see the "ripples" and where we may have the opportunity to work a more thorough 10th Step.



From the Early History of AA in Jacksonville:

In April of 1941, Tom S. went to the local evening newspaper, The Jacksonville Journal, and spoke with the City Editor, telling him of the national AA movement and what they were doing at the local level. As a result of this contact with the Jacksonville Journal article appeared in the Journal on April 18th written by Lowell Clucas. At the end of the article Mr. Clucas stated that anyone interested may write him care of the Jacksonville Journal and he would pass the inquiry on to the local AA organization. One of the first letters came the next day from Hugh C. wishing to get in touch with the local AA group. Hugh C., Charlie P., and Bruce H. were the first people to answer the Journal article. Hugh committed suicide after eight years of sobriety; his suicide was not due to alcoholism but another personal matter. Charlie died with nineteen years of sobriety and Bruce dies with eighteen years.

4/10/1939 - The first ten copies of the Big Book arrived at the office Bill shared with Hank Parkhurst in Newark, New Jersey.

4/11/1939 - Marty Mann attended her first meeting at the home of Bill and Lois Wilson in Brooklyn.

4/11/1941 - Bill and Lois Wilson moved into their new home, Stepping Stones.

4/26/1939 - Bill & Lois Wilson moved in with Hank Parkhurst after the bank foreclosed on 182 Clinton St. This was the first of over 50 moves before they acquired Stepping Stones.

4/30/1989 - The film "My Name is Bill W.," a Hallmark Hall of Fame presentation, was broadcast on ABC
