





AT 67TH FLORIDA STATE CONVENTION**

The NE Florida Intergroup and North Florida Area Conference Archives Committee Chairs hosted the Archives rooms on August 2 and 3 of the 67th Florida State Convention. In addition to historical displays and numerous photographs taken with silhouettes of our Founders the hundreds of visitors to the Archives rooms heard six speakers from Areas 1, 14 and 15 as well as Northeast Florida and Volusia County Intergroup share the rich history of Alcoholics Anonymous in the State of Florida, the first trip of four local members to Akron for Founders Day 2024 and the procedures and equipment used by Northeast Florida Intergroup to interview, transcribe and publish the stories of long-timers in Northeast Florida. There were also numerous movies of our founders as well as Sister Ignatia and Father Martin. Visitors were invited to take pictures outside the home of the first AA meeting in the State of Florida held at 2747 Riverside Avenue in January 1941. Everything was very well received.

The Northeast Florida Archives Committee invites everyone to join the Committee and help us plan a local Archives workshop in early December. The next Florida AA Archives Workshop will be held in Panama City on February 22, 2025.




