History of Central Group's Annual Fish Fry and Old-Timer's AA Meeting



In the mid-seventies some young men who liked to drink and fish found themselves getting sober together at Central Group. They also found that fishing was even more fun sober. Sometimes they used Herman's boat with Winston C. as captain. At other times they fished off the north jetties in JAX Beach. John S., Layton, Ernie G., Virgil B., Ed B. and Amil Q. did most of the fishing but Harry O., Virginia C., Bobby G., and Bill G. were also involved.

John S. recalled one time when Winston and another member left Mayport by boat and collected John and his son at the old public boat ramp that used to be down on the South Bank of the St. John's. Over by St. Vincent's hospital. They found a "croaker hole" and pulled in enough fish to cover the bottom of the boat. Sometimes they borrowed David G.'s seine, a large net with sinkers on one and floats on the other. It took a lot of strength to work the net so Amil Q., who was over six feet tall and a full-blooded Indian, got the job as "point man". They would wade out with that 100-foot net and Amil was so big he would still be wading long after the others had to swim. One of those times they hauled the net in full of sheep heads.

Eventually everybody's freezers were full of fish so they decided to cook them in what used to be a vacant lot next to the San Marco clubhouse. That was the summer of 1974 and was the first Fish Fry. It was so much fun that they did it again the next year. More people joined in and Bobby G.'s band played music. It attracted a lot of neighborhood folks. In 1977, things got semi-organized and semi-official. The Fish Fry became a celebration of the Group's anniversary and "Old-Timers with 15 years or more shared at the evening meeting. Later it was changed to 20 years to be an "Old-Timer" and the whole affair took on the eating meeting format we have today.

For the years 1981 thru 1983, while the club was being remodeled, the Fish Fry was temporarily held at Unity Church on Lomax Street thanks to Candy and Ed B. In 1984, the Fish Fry came back home and it was decided it would always be held on the second Saturday in May. Early on Vasco cooked the fish, Bill G. chaired the meetings and Rose Z. kept the list of "Old-Timers" and other records. Many others have been faithful in helping, especially Harry O. (now deceased) whose fish market continued to provide fish after the big fishing trips ended. Many of the members who started the Fish Fry have passed on but are with us in the spirit of the gathering we enjoy each year.

(2011 Update)

For the past 2-3 years the Fish Fry has been held at Swaim Memorial United Methodist Church which is located close to the San Marco clubhouse where the Central Group meets. Denise L. and Lisa F. have been the faithful coordinators and the Fish Fry is now held in the spring each year whenever the Church is available.

(2023 update)

The Fish Fry has been back at the San Marco clubhouse for several years. It was held this year on April 15th and was the 48th Annual Fish Fry.

All of the sign-in books from 1974 to the present along with other Fish Fry memorabilia, are kept at the San Marco Club.
