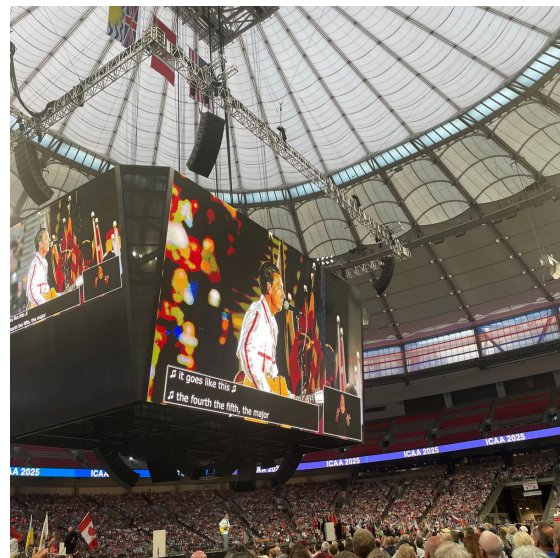
2025 International Convention

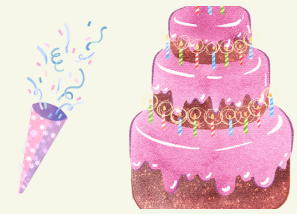
In Vancouver, British Columbia

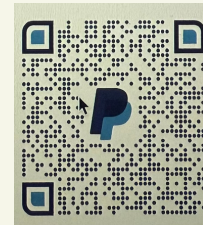

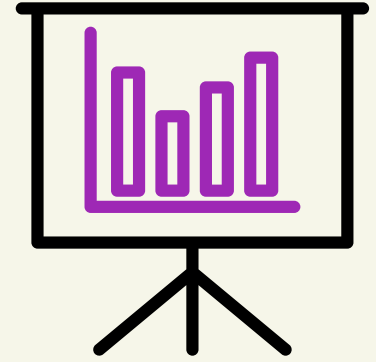
